BD Barcelona Design is the Spanish furniture editor with the most international prestige. Founded in 1972, its catalogue features designs from the most important contemporary creators including Álvaro Siza Vieira, Ettore Sottsass, Oscar Tusquets, Lluís Clotet, Alfredo Häberli, Jaime Hayon, Konstantin Grcic, Ross Lovegrove, Doshi Levien and Campana Brothers, among others, as well historic names such as Gaudí and artists like Salvador Dalí. During its long existence, BD has been recognised by the Spanish Premio Nacional de Diseño (1989), the European Community Design Prize (1990) and the Red Dot Design Award 'best of the best' in 2011.
























